AARON NATHAN PRICE (b. 1990) is graduating the University of Connecticut this semester with a B.M. in Music Composition. He has been formally studying composition with Dr. Kenneth Fuchs and Professor Earl MacDonald since 2010, and has been composing on his own since the age of 14.

In 2012, Aaron was invited to the Atlantic Music Festival, where he had the honor of taking private lessons with David Ludwig, George Tsontakis, Stephen Cabell, and Andrew Thomas. Aaron was commissioned in 2010 by St. Mark's Episcopal Chapel in Storrs, CT to compose a text-setting of a psalm. This summer, Aaron's composition "Amber Veil" will be featured on the debut album of Apple Orange Pair, a talented horn and harp duo from Yale.

Aaron also studies clarinet with Professor Curt Blood and performs with the University of Connecticut Wind Ensembles and has performed with the University Symphonic Band and University Clarinet Quartet. Before attending the University of Connecticut he studied at the Conservatorio Profesional de Música Joaquín Villatoro in Jerez de la Frontera, Spain. Aaron attended Wilton High School in Wilton, CT where he participated in the Warrior Marching Band, Honors Jazz Band, and Wind Ensemble.
