Meeting of Executive Committee held Sept. 10, 1930 2.

- 4. The following sabbatic leave was recommended by the President and approved by the Executive Committee.
  - a. L. A. Alexander, leave to continue graduate study at Teachers' College for first semester 1930-31.
- 5. IT WAS VOTED: to include in the Experiment Station budget, for the next biennium, an appropriation of \$10,000 for the investigation of Mastitis, in accordance with a request presented by the Agricultural Leaders Policy Conference.
- 6. A committee composed of Dr. Wood, Mr. Buckingham and Dr. McCracken was appointed to arrange with the Manufacturers Association of Connecticut for a meeting at Storrs in November. This meeting is suggested by Mr. J. B. Thwing for the purpose of stimulating interest in support of development of a first-class engineering school at Storrs.
- 7. The two-year budgets for the three divisions were re-considered and revised, making the requests for state appropriations for the years 1931-32 and 1932-33 as follows:
